Many volunteers have wondered what MOWCC's protocol is should we learn of a client testing positive for COVID-19. Our volunteers will not deliver any meals to any clients who are suspected or confirmed positive. The safety of our volunteers and clients are our number one concern as we fight hunger amongst our vulnerable seniors and disabled community.

The moment we learn about a positive case amongst our clients, that client is immediately pulled off of the volunteer's route and a special weekly delivery is set-up between the client and our trained staff. Only after the client is cleared will the client be back on their regular route.

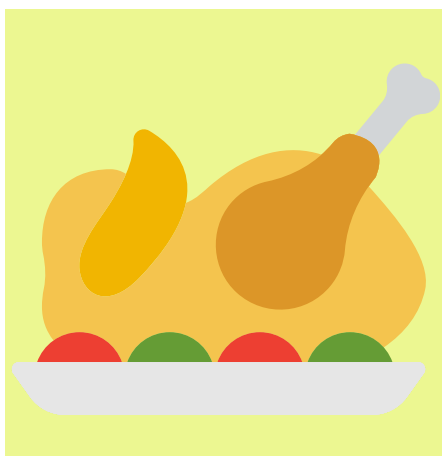
